The Commons in Northbrook Condominium Association is a 79 unit development in Northbrook that was having a hard time addressing deteriorating masonry throughout the complex. We had been addressing it piecemeal for many years, throwing good money into a never ending issue. Management reached out to a number of architects to seek bids for a property wide project. This was a difficult situation as not all of the masonry needed to be replaced. J. Hershey were the only bidder willing to work with such a difficult project. The Board of Directors were made up of two architects and an engineer when we originally hired Hershey Architecture on as our consultant. They provided thoughtful analysis, personal meetings with the Board members, and a place to get their questions answered about everything from lintels to caulking.
